Kindly provide responses to the following queries: 1. Regulations for Paramotor Flying: Has the Government of India framed any rules for Paramotor flying? If so, please provide a copy of the applicable regulations. 2. Recognition of Governing Bodies: Does DGCA recognize any national or international bodies for Paramotor or Paragliding sports? If yes, please provide the list of recognized organizations. 3. International Associations: Is APPI, USHPA, BHPA, or any other international organization recognized by DGCA for Paramotor flying? If yes, kindly provide the details. 4. Licensing for Paramotor Flying: Does DGCA issue licenses for Paramotor pilots? If yes, please outline the formalities and requirements for obtaining a license. 5. Authorized Licensing Bodies: Has DGCA empowered any organization in India to issue licenses for Paramotor flying? If yes, kindly provide their details. 6. ATC Clearance for Paramotor Flying: Is the Air Traffic Control (ATC) under the Airports Authority of India (AAI) empowered to grant permission for Paramotor flying? If yes, what is the procedure for obtaining clearance? 7. Airspace Regulation Radius by ATC, AAI: Up to what radius in km does ATC regulate airspace around airports? If a paramotor flight is conducted beyond 10 km from an airport, is ATC clearance required? Please provide details on when clearance is mandatory.

Point No. 6: ATC Clearance for Paramotor Flying: Reply: Yes, the ATC under AAI is responsible for the provision of Air Traffic Services for safe and efficient flight operation, within AAI controlled airspace. Therefore, any flying activity is required to be undertaken with due clearance/coordination from/with the respective ATC unit. The concerned person undertaking the flying activity is required to contact the respective ATC unit for obtaining the clearance. The jurisdiction of ATC authorities are defined in AIP India, available in public domain on AAI website www.aai.aero. The clearance from ATC unit is strictly from airspace management perspective only. The flying activities are also subject to approvals from other local/regulatory authorities as applicable.
