I am to refer to your Request for Information under RTI Act 2005, received vide letter dated 13/12/2025 and to say that *The duties and responsibilities of the Chief Security Officer (CSO) of an Airport under Airports Authority of India as per prescribed under the National Civil Aviation Security Programme (NCASP), 2024.*

The CSO is responsible for acting as the nodal point for security coordination with DG, BCAS, Annual review and updating of the Annual Security Programme, coordination and supervision of implementation of security measures, liaison with CSO of aircraft operators and other airport stakeholders, recommending security-related design and infrastructure features as per NCASP, maintaining records of unlawful interference incidents, initiating enquiries in case of suspected acts of unlawful interference or sabotage, conducting periodic security reviews with airport management and coordinating internal quality control activities, including BCAS audits, inspections, and corrective actions..

In case, you want to go for an appeal in connection with the information provided, you may appeal to the Appellate Authority indicated below within **thirty days** from the date of receipt of this letter.
