The reply to the queries specific to NSCBI Airport, Kolkata are as under :-


Sl. No.	Information Sought.	Reply.
1.	Kindly share the list of airports where either AAI or the concerned airport has a contract agreement or partnership with Uber India for designated parking or related things?	Uber has a contract agreement with AAI, Kolkata Airport under which it is operating as Application Based Cab Aggregator at NSCBI Airport, Kolkata.
2.	Kindly share how much Uber is paying on a trip basis to these airports individually? What kind of charges are there? Pickup charges, parking charges or anything else?	Uber is paying Rs.80/- per trip to AAI, Kolkata (NSCBI Airport). In addition to this, Uber is liable to pay parking charges directly to the Car Parking Licensee.
