The reply to the queries are as under :-

Sl. No.	Information Sought.	Reply.
1.	Can we operate a shop at an airport without a Security Program?	Compliance of Aircraft (Security) Rules, 2003 and related BCAS guidelines are binding on all entities including 'Business Establishments' (shops) operating inside airports.
2.	Kindly provide SOP.	The Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) related to aviation security are classified as 'Sensitive Aviation Security Information' and are marked as 'Restricted' documents as per the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS). Therefore, the requested information cannot be provided as it is exempted from disclosure under Section 8(1)(a) of the RTI Act, 2005, as it pertains to the security, strategic, scientific or economic interest of the State.

As per Section 19 of the Right to Information Act 2005, if you are not satisfied with the reply you can file an appeal with the First Appellate Authority within 30 days of the issue of this order, whose particulars are as under :-
