The reply to the queries specific to NSCBI Airport, Kolkata are as under :-


Sl. No.	Information sought.	Reply.
1.	Under which rules and regulations 100% cashless system has been implemented i.e. all or any services will be rendered through cashless system only?	At NSCBI Airport, Kolkata in addition to UPI/Debit Card/Credit Card facility, payment by mode of cash is also allowed.
2.	If any passengers do not want to use UPI or Digital Payment and want to pay in cash only, whether he will be allowed or not?	
3.	Whether passenger will be detained at parking if he refused to pay the Parking fee in digital mode?	
4.	Is 100% cashless Airports means cash payments are totally banned at that airports?	
5.	What are the remedial actions are available with passenger who wants to pay in cash only?
