The reply to the query specific to NSCBI Airport, Kolkata are as under :-


Information Sought.	Reply.

At present, NSCBI Airport, Kolkata does not have a dedicated prayer room for passengers. Prayer room are not a mandatory facility at airports, and such provisions are considered on a case-to-case basis, subject to availability of space and fulfillment of necessary security norms.
