1.	Kindly provide the information as to number of ambulances Basic Life Support Advanced Life Support Mobile Intensive Care Unit and Critical Care Transport available on each airport in India. Kindly provide the availability of each ambulance and number of ambulances available on each airport.	At Kolkata Airport, an ambulance is deployed on the city side under the operation of the Medical Inspection Room. The ambulance is equipped with Basic Life Support (BLS) facilities and is available 24x7 for medical emergencies. Ambulances with Airport Fire Services, Kolkata Airport : i) Basic Life Support – 04 nos. ii) Advanced Life Support – Nil. iii) Mobile Intensive Care Unit – Nil. iv) Critical Care Unit – Nil.
2.	Kindly provide the information of doctors and nurses available on each airport in India. Kindly provide all information what kind of medical aid is provided on airports to passengers in India. Kindly provide all information.	At Kolkata Airport, medical services are provided round the clock, in accordance with the criteria of Annexure 9. In each shift, one qualified doctor, one paramedical staff, and one nurse are deployed to attend to medical requirements. Round the clock (24x7) medical support is available inside the terminal for passengers who fall sick or require urgent medical attention. One dedicated Medical Inspection Room is located at the New Integrated Terminal Building (NITB), Arrival Area, for providing immediate medical examination and first aid services.
3.	Are airports in India having tie up with nearby hospitals for passenger medical issues and medical emergencies. Kindly provide all information.	Kolkata Airport provides basic medical/first-aid support, and serious emergencies are referred to nearby hospitals, including Manipal Hospitals in Kolkata.
