As per the current security protocols and rules laid down by the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS), only passengers with valid tickets are allowed inside the terminal, who carry a government photo identity card. Entry for non-passengers is strictly prohibited. There is no gallery available for visitors to view aircraft operations.
