The reply to the query of Point No.3 is as under :-



Kindly provide details of actions taken against concessionaires found violating pricing rules, such as warnings, fines, termination of contracts, or blacklisting.	Since the information sought is for more than five financial years & quite voluminous in nature, you are requested to visit the Office of General Manager (Ops.-TM)/Dy. General Manager (Ops.-TM)/Public Grievance Officer for inspection of documents/records as per Section-2(j) (i) of RTI Act, 2005.
