As per Concession Agreement signed, please confirm the date on which the Concessionaire (TDI) is handed over physical possession of the approved location (after completion of the contractual formalities like acceptance of LOIA, submission of the security deposit, signing of agreement etc.) within the incubation period.	The day on which handing over of physical possession of approved sites is considered as 29.10.2018, 61 st day from the date issuance of LOIA (After 60 days of incubation period) as per the RFP provisions.
2.	Please provide the data on the Concession Fee (licence fee) received as per the terms and conditions of the Concession Agreement till date and is the concessionaire paying the bill by the 25 th every month or any Outstanding Dues are receivables.	The License Fee paid by agency for First Concession year is Rs.5,34,24,000/- plus GST and other applicable charges. Currently the License is in the 2 nd Concession Year and the License fee has been escalated by 10% as per the provision of the Concession Agreement. There are outstanding dues receivable as on date.
3.	Please provide details of the on-going disputes and differences raised concerning the Concession Agreement signed between the AAI and TDI and its status.	Disclosure of the information is exempted under clause 8 (1)(d) of the RTI act.
4.	As per Article -19, please confirm if any "Concessionaire Event of Default" has accrued and notice of dissatisfaction, informing the Concessionaire of its reasoned intent to terminate the Agreement or any Notice of Termination has been issued to the concessionaire (TDI International India (P) Ltd).	Disclosure of the information is exempted under clause 8 (1)(d) of the RTI act.
5.	How much square feet of the advertisement display area is occupied by the concessionaire within indoor/outdoor of Chennai airport jurisdiction?	A total of 16000 sqft is allotted to Concessionaire under present License awarded for Exclusive advertisement Rights.
6.	In the current scenario of Covid-19 is "Concession Fee Holiday Period" entitled to the Concessionaire and any kind of Concession fee waiver or proportionate rebate has been granted for payment of concession fee.	Yes. Relief is under consideration as per the circular of AAI, CHQ subject to certain conditions mentioned therein.
