No record available with this office containing details of trainees allowed to do training with beard at 53rd officers course conducted at FTI New Delhi from 05-05-2025 to 16-06-2025.
3	Provide the copy of Documents in fire safety manual that mension the details religions allowed to keep beard during training at fire training centres , Kolkata and Delhi.During training and any individual representation required to do training with beard ?	No record available with this office that mentions the details of religions allowed to keep beard at fire training Institutes, New Delhi and Kolkata Centres during training. Individual representations received to undergo training with beard at FTI New Delhi/ Kolkata centres involves personal information and no large public interest is established. Hence it is exempted to be disclosed under section 8(1)(j) of the RTI act, 2005.
4	As per fire safety manual para 13.2.2 mensions that fire executive should wearAAI Uniform

	Shirts Full sleeves (double pocket with flap & shoulder flap as per uniform design of Central Industrial Security Force or any other Para military force, Govt. of India). And as per para 13.2.3 mentions that for non executive AAI Uniform Shirts Full sleeves (double pocket with flap & shoulder flap as per uniform design of Central Industrial Security Force or any other Para military force, Govt. of India). And also as per 13.5.2 All Fire Service Personnel Should stitch their AAI(Summer and Winter)Uniform like Central Industrial Security Force(Para Militar y Force, Govt.of India) and wear as per various occasion mentioned in Para- 6. But it has been observed that many officials at AAI fire stations, FTI-Delhi and FTI-Kolkata both executive and non executive violating the above uniform rules even it is a important safety matter. Any circular issued for the strict complience to follow the respective uniform rules?if yes provide copies of such circulars and Any disciplinary action/action based on disciplinary ground taken against the official for violating the uniform rules as per Fire safety manual?if yes provide the name of official who undergone disciplinary action/or action based on disciplinary ground .	No record available with this office in respect of any circular issued for the strict compliance to follow the respective uniform rules. No record available with this office in respect of disciplinary action taken based on disciplinary ground against any of the official for violating the Fire safety manual para 13.2.2, 13.2.3 and 13.5.2 at FTI New Delhi & Kolkata centres.
5	If circular is not issued regarding the above matter ,provide the clarification for non issuance such circular even blindly knows that it is a pure violation of fire safety manual and its important in case of fireman safety and passenger safety.	The information sought is in the nature of seeking queries/clarifications or interpretations which is outside the purview of the RTI act 2005.
6	As per fire safety manual it has been clearly mensions that the beard is allowed as per uniform policy govt of India for other religious and it has been observed that the both fire training centers at Delhi and Kolkata relieving the trainees on disciplinary ground without providing any clarification regarding the matter even the fire manual allowing the trainees to do training with beard .So kindly provide the details of religions allowed to do training with beard and kindly provide the copy of respective document.	No record available with this office that contain the details of religions allowed to do training with beard.

In case the applicant is not satisfied with the information provided, appeal can be preferred within 30 days before the First Appellate Authority, Executive Director (Tech), Airports Authority of India, Rajiv Gandhi Bhawan, New Delhi-110003.
