



**10. POWERS RELATING TO REMISSION / WAIVER OF
DEMURRAGE CHARGES (CARGO)**

10.1 GENERAL

- 10.1.1 Subject to such policy, rules and procedures as may be described the authorities specified here under are authorised to sanction, in consultation with the Finance and Accounts Department, remission / waiver of demurrage charges regarding Cargo Operations.
- 10.1.2 With a view to optimize the scarce / limited cargo storage and processing facilities at Integrated Cargo Complexes at airports and to ensure expeditious turnover of cargo, it has been decided to revise waiver policy as per the provisions of the IAAI (now AAI) Storage and Processing of Goods Regulations, 1993.
- 10.1.3 In exercise of the powers vested in the Chairperson under Section 6(1) of IAAI now AAI Storage & Processing of Goods Regulations, 1993, the following directives / guidelines / policies lay down the circumstances, limits, financial delegations for waiver of demurrage charges which will come into effect from the day this instrument comes into force.
- 10.1.4 Subject to Clause 10.1.5 below, this policy shall be applicable to all cargo / goods received and processed by the Authority after this policy comes into effect. This will also cover all initial applications received and pending decision for grant of waiver of demurrage charges in respect of cargo / goods received, processed; but not cleared prior to the set date.
- 10.1.5 This policy, however, will not be applicable to any appeal pending under the erstwhile policy in respect of waiver of demurrage charges, where the decision has already been communicated. Such cases will continue to be governed under the then extant policy.
- 10.1.6 All applications for waiver of demurrage charges shall be submitted within 15 calendar days from the date the 'Passed-out-of-Charge' is issued by the Customs authorities. Delay beyond 15 days for submission of such applications, cases of which shall be sent to Hqrs. for the decision of the Member (Ops.), reasons for condonation of delay to be recorded and justified with the concurrence of local finance.
- 10.1.7 If a day(s) is / are declared by Central Government as unscheduled holiday(s) within the free period, the free period will be extended by the said number of day(s).

10.2.12 Part withheld Consignments

In case where a part of a Consignment is withheld by the customs the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver of demurrage charges as indicated:

Authority	Limits of Powers
<i>Dy. General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 80% remission upto 90 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>

NOTE: I. The powers indicated above may be exercised *On the Spot* without prior financial concurrence. However, such cases may be reported to Airport Director / General Manager (Cargo) and sent for financial scrutiny on the next working day.

10.2.13 Consignments where the Demurrage Charges exceed the customs assessed CIF value.

In such cases the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver of demurrage charges as indicated:

Authority	Limits of Powers
<i>ED (Cargo)/ Airport Directors / GM (Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 200% of the customs assessed CIF value.</i>

NOTE: I. Documents indicating customs assessed value must be obtained and kept on record.

II. For part delivery sought under this clause, CIF value of the whole consignment will be taken for computing the quantum of relief.

10.2.14 Re-Exportation

In cases where imported consignments have to be re-exported the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver of demurrage charges as indicated:

<i>Chairperson</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 50% remission upto 45 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>
<i>Whole Time Member (Operations)</i>	<i>Upto Rs.0.50 lakhs in each case subject to 50% remission upto 45 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>
<i>Executive Director (Cargo)</i>	<i>Upto Rs. 0.35 lakhs in each case subject to</i>

10.2.15 Recalled Exports

In cases where consignments are originally exported but recalled before crossing the Indian borders and returned to the airport of origin duly manifested as import cargo the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver of demurrage charges as indicated:

<i>ED (Cargo)/ Airport Directors /G M (Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 60% remission upto 30 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied.</i>

10.3 EXPORTS:

10.3.1 Free Period

Subject to the directives of Central Government/AAI Management shall amend and notify the free period from time to time.

10.3.2 Shipments requiring clearance by Govt. Regulatory Agencies viz., Archaeological Survey of India / Wild Life Conservation Authority of India

Subject to prescribed Governmental Regulatory Agency/ Customs Authority's decision and submission of detention certificate the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver of demurrage charges as indicated:

Authority	Limits of Powers
<i>ED (Cargo)/Airport Directors / GM (Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 80% remission upto 45 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>
<i>Dy. General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Rs.0.25 lakhs in each case subject to 80% remission upto 45 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>

10.3.3 Plant Quarantine / Fumigation / Analytical Test / Special Investigation Branch / Export Trade Control or similar cases:



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Subject to prescribed Governmental Regulatory Agency/ Customs Authority's decision and submission of relevant detention certificate the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver of demurrage charges as indicated:

Authority	Limits of Powers
<i>ED (Cargo)/ Airport Directors / GM (Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 80% remission upto 6 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>
<i>Dy. General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Rs.0.25 lakhs in each case subject to 80% remission upto 6 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>

10.3.4 Appeal Cases:

Subject to prescribed Customs authority's decision in respect of cases referred to Central Appellate Tribunal, any other quasi-judicial authority such as CEGAT or judicial Civil Courts, High Courts, Supreme Court where no fine, penalty or warning has been imposed on the consignee and submission of detention certificate the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver charges as indicated:

Authority	Limits of Powers
<i>ED (Cargo)/ Airport Directors / GM(Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 80% remission for the period of pendency of court proceeding or as per directives of the court.</i>
<i>Dy. General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Rs.0.25 lakhs in each case subject to 80% remission for the period of pendency of court proceeding or as per directives of the court.</i>

10.3.5 Shipments where the Demurrage Charges exceed the FOB value.

In such cases the following authorities may sanction remission/ waiver of demurrage charges as indicated.

Authority	Limits of Powers
<i>ED (Cargo)/ Airport Directors / GM(Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers beyond 200% of the custom assessed FOB value.</i>

Note:

- I. Documents indicating customs assessed value must be obtained and kept on record.
- II. For part delivery sought under this clause, FOB value of the whole shipment will be taken for computing the quantum of remission.



10.3.6 Recalled Shipments

In case where the Export Shipments are not uplifted for any bonafide reasons and consequently recalled by the Shipper, Exporter from the cargo Terminal the following authorities may sanction remission/ waiver of demurrage charges as indicated

Authority	Limits of Powers
<i>Airport Directors / General Manager(Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 60% remission for the first 15 days and 30% for next 15 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied.</i>

10.4 TRANSSHIPMENT CARGO

For inbound trans-shipment cargo originated from abroad and destined to foreign station, clause (s) applicable for imports will be taken into account and for waiver for demurrage charges for outbound trans-shipment originated from Indian Ports, clause (s) applicable for Export will be taken into consideration.



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10.1.8 Processing period of waiver applications shall be regulated as under:-

- a) In cases where demurrage is waived in full and/or part total processing period shall be considered as free period.
- b) In case where application is rejected, the processing period beyond ten working days after receipt of complete details / documents / explanations should be treated as free period.
- c) Maximum three working days free period shall be allowed from the date of communicating the decision, beyond which full demurrage charges shall be levied.

10.1.9 An appeal against the decision of rejection of the application for waiver can be made to the next higher authority than the deciding authority. The appeal shall be filed within a period of fifteen days of communication of such decision. The decision of the appellate authority, however, will be treated as final.

10.1.10 Demurrage charges shall not be waived where:

- (a) Any fine / penalty / personal penalty / warning is imposed by the Customs Authority.
- (b) Delay arose by reason of dispute in the assessable value or for revalidating or correcting the license in ordinary course of appraisal.

10.1.11 Monthly Return showing the details of waiver cases granted by Cargo department duly classifying cases under Rs. 25000 and over Rs. 25000 alongwith waiver clauses under which such waiver granted.

10.1.12 General Manager (Cargo), IGI Airport shall exercise all the powers vested with Airport Director, IGI Airport in so far as it relates to Cargo operations at Delhi only, until it is revised.

10.2. **IMPORTS**

10.2.1 Free Period:

In case of imports the following free period (Period for which no demurrage charges are levied) shall be allowed subject to directives of Central Govt./AAI Management on this subject:-

*Unaccompanied baggage
under TR rules*

*Free period shall be determined by AAI Board/
Government of India from time to time*

*All other cargo not converted
not covered as unaccompanied
baggage under TR rules*

*Free period shall be determined by AAI Board/
Government of India from time to time*

***10.2.2 Transfer of Residence (Appeal Cases):**

Where the appellate Customs Authority decides the case the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver charges as indicated.

<i>Airport Directors / ED (C) / General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 80% remission for the period of detention thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied.</i>
<i>Dy. General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Upto Rs. 0.25 lakhs in each case subject to 80% remission for the period of detention thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied.</i>
<i>Sr. Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Upto Rs. 0.10 lakhs in each case subject to 80% remission for the period of detention, thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied. A monthly report of cases waived by him shall be sent to GM(Cargo).</i>

10.2.3 Commercial Importation:

(a) Analytical test by Customs / Central Control Laboratory:

Subject to prescribed Customs Authority's decision and submission of detention certificate the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver charges as indicated.

Authority	Limits of Powers
<i>ED (Cargo)/Airport Directors / GM (Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 100% remission for the first 30 days and 80% remission beyond that.</i>
<i>Dy. General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Upto Rs.0.25 lakhs in each case subject to 100% remission for the first 30 days and 80% remission beyond that.</i>

(b) Import Trade Control Cases:

Subject to prescribed Customs Authority's decision on ITC cases and submission of detention certificate the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver charges as indicated:

Authority	Limits of Powers
ED (Cargo)/Airport Directors / GM (Cargo)	Full power subject to 80% remission for the first 90 days only, thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied.
Dy. General Manager (Cargo)	Upto Rs.0.25 lakhs in each case subject to 80% remission for the first 90 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied.

(c) Import Trade Control Violation Cases:

Subject to prescribed Customs Authority's decision where the consignee has been cautioned of ITC violation and submission of detention certificate the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver charges as indicated: (However this would not include the cases indicated vide sub-clause (a) & (b) of 10.1.10).

ED (Cargo)/Airport Directors / GM (Cargo)	Full Powers subject to 50% remission for the first 90 days and 25% remission for the next 90 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied.

(d) Quarantine / Fumigation Cases:

Subject to prescribed Customs Authority's decision where the entire consignment is shifted to the Plant Quarantine / Fumigation department and submission of detention certificate the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver charges as indicated:

<i>ED (Cargo)/ Airport Directors / GM (Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers for the period the consignment remained with Plant Quarantine / Fumigation department</i>
<i>Dy. General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Upto Rs.0.25 lakhs in each case for the period the consignment remained with Plant Quarantine / Fumigation department</i>
<i>Sr. Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Upto Rs.0.10 lakhs in each case for the period the consignment remained with Plant Quarantine / Fumigation department</i>

(e) Quarantine / Fumigation Cases (Representative Samples)

Subject to prescribed Customs Authority's decision where only representative samples are shifted to the Plant Quarantine / Fumigation department leaving the cargo at Cargo Complex and submission of detention certificate the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver charges as indicated:

<i>ED (Cargo)/ Airport Directors / GM (Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 80 % remission for the first 50 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied.</i>
<i>Dy. General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Upto Rs.0.25 lakhs in each case subject to 80 % remission for the first 50 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied.</i>

(f) Censor Board Cases:

Subject to prescribed Customs Authority's decision in respect of cases referred to censor board and submission of detention certificate the following authorities may sanction remission waiver charges as indicated:

(g) Special Investigation Cases

Subject to prescribed Customs Authority's decision in respect of cases referred to Special Investigation branch of Customs and submission of detention certificate the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver charges as indicated:

(h) Appeal Cases:

Subject to prescribed Customs Authority's decision in respect of cases referred to Central Appellate Tribunal, any other quasi-judicial Authority such as CEGAT, Civil Courts, High Courts, Supreme Court where no fine, penalty or warning has been imposed on the consignee and submission of detention certificate the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver charges as indicated:

***10.2.4 Non-commercial importation**

Subject to prescribed Customs Authority's decision and submission of valid documentary evidence certifying the non-commercial and non-profitable status of:

- Govt. / Non-Profitable / Non-Commercial Hospitals.
 - Diplomatic Missions and Diplomats (Subject to production of CDEC).
 - Govt. Educational Institutions / Universities.
 - International Voluntary Bodies like UNO, UNESCO, WHO, FAO, RED CROSS, CARE, ICRISAT etc.
 - Research Institutes / Charitable Institutions (Non-Profitable/Non-Commercial)
- following authorities may sanction remission / waiver of demurrage charges as indicated:

10.2.5 Waiver in Deserving cases

In deserving cases, such as, non-profit making organizations, institutions, establishments, etc., where the customs have waived customs duty in full, the Chairperson may at his discretion approve 100% waiver of demurrage charges.

*10.2.6 Compassionate Cases

Subject to prescribed Customs Authority's decision and submission of valid documentary evidence in respect of non-commercial cargo like gifts (excluding personal gifts), life saving drugs or equipment of personal usage the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver of demurrage charges as indicated:

<i>Whole Time Member (Operations)</i>	<i>Upto Rs.0.50 lakhs in each case subject to 100% remission upto 45 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>
<i>Executive Director (Cargo)</i>	<i>Upto Rs. 0.35 lakhs in each case subject to 50% remission upto 120 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>
<i>Airport Directors / General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Upto Rs.0.25 lakhs in each case subject to 100% remission upto 45 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>
<i>Dy.General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Upto Rs.0.05 lakhs in each subject to 100% remission upto 45 days only thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>

10.2.8 Personal Effects of AAI Employees

Subject to prescribed Customs Authority's decision and submission of valid documentary evidence in respect of personal effects of the regular / ex-employees the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver of demurrage charges as indicated:

<i>ED (Cargo)/ Airport Directors / GM(Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 80% remission upto 120 days only in respect of regular employees and 50% remission upto 120 days only in respect of ex-employees thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>

***10.2.9 AAI's Consignments**

Subject to prescribed Customs Authority's decision and submission of valid documentary evidence the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver of demurrage charges as indicated:

<i>ED (Cargo)/ Airport Directors / G M (Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers</i>

10.2.10 Untraceable Consignments

In respect of Untraceable Consignments, the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver of demurrage charges as indicated:

<i>Dy. General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers for the untraceable period, thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>

 - II. *The Powers indicated above may be exercised On the Spot without prior financial concurrence. However, such cases may be reported to Airport Director / General Manager (Cargo) and sent for financial scrutiny on the next working day.*
 - III. *A monthly report of all such cases to be sent to Executive Director (F&A) by the head of the Finance Department at the Unit.*

10.2.11 Damaged Consignments

In respect of Damaged Consignments, the following authorities may sanction remission / waiver of demurrage charges as indicated:

<i>Dy. General Manager (Cargo)</i>	<i>Full Powers subject to 100% remission upto 5 Customs working days thereafter proportionate to damage liability, thereafter full Demurrage charges shall be levied</i>

1. AAI is presently charging parking charges @ 50% of housing charges. The present housing charges and parking charges are as under:

3. The parking charges after the financial incentives in night parking charges to all operators between 22.00 hrs to 06.00 hrs will be as under:



Subject: Revision of Unit Rate of Route Navigation Facility Charges

Sir,

Ministry of Civil Aviation has approved the revision of Unit Rate (i.e. R) used for working out RNF Charges from Rs 4020/- to Rs 4200/- with immediate effect vide letter No G.17018/17/2003-AAI dated 20th April 2006. The revised Unit Rate of Rs 4200 shall be applicable for landing as well as overflying flights for raising bills of RNF Charges.

The formulae for working out RNF Charges for landing and overflying flights stand revised as under:

$$C = W * D * R + FC$$

W = SQRT (MAU-WEIGHT in kg/50000), capped at 2, 00,000 kg

D = SQRT (Great Circle Distance in NM /100), capped at 1200 NM.

R = Unit Rate

FC = Fixed Charge of INR 4,000 for overflights(not landing in India).

The revised Unit Rate(R) will be INR 4200

The Regions/Airports are requested to raise the RNFC bills considering the revised unit rate of Rs 4200 effective from 00.00 hours of 21.04.2006 and also keep informed all airlines and airports under your control.
