

AIR TRAFFIC REPORT – FEBRUARY, 2018

During the month of February 2018, all operational airports (taken together) handled 191.44 thousand aircraft movements (excluding General Aviation Movements), 26.34 million passengers and 262.61 thousand tonnes of freight. The details are given in the following table:-

The above table reveals that the aircraft movements, passenger and freight traffic have increased by 17.0 per cent, 20.4 per cent and 9.6 per cent respectively at all Indian airports taken together during February 2018 over February 2017.

TRAFFIC TREND:

(APRIL– FEBRUARY) 2017-18 VIS-À-VIS (APRIL– FEBRUARY) 2016-17

Aircraft Movements

The international and domestic aircraft movements have witnessed an increase of 9.5 per cent and 13.9 per cent respectively resulting into 13.0 per cent increase in total aircraft movements during (April- February) 2017-18 as compared to (April- February) 2016-17.

Passengers

The international and domestic passengers traffic have shown an increase of 10.1 per cent and 17.4 per cent respectively resulting into overall increase of 15.8 per cent in total passenger traffic during the period (April- February) 2017-18 as compared to (April- February) 2016-17.

Freight

The international and domestic freight traffic have shown growth of 17.2 per cent and 8.0 per cent respectively resulting into overall increase of 13.7 per cent in total freight traffic during the period (April- February) 2017-18 as compared to (April- February) 2016-17.
