Subject: Major Airports-reg.

Ministry of Civil Aviation may kindly refer to Circular No. AV.24032/03/2009-AAI dated 12.03.2010 and Circular No. AV.24032/03/2009-AAI dated 21.10.2010 wherein 13 airports including 2 Civil Enclaves were stated to be major airports as defined in clause (i) of Section 2 of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008.

2(i) The Airports Authority of India vide letter No. AAI/CHQ/Tariff/MYTP/2018-19/578 dated 22.10.2018 has indicated that as per the tariff statistics for the year 2016-17, the following 3 airports crossed the 1.5 million passengers per annum mark in the said year.

Sl. No.	Airport	No. of Passengers in millions (FY. 2017-18)
1	Bagdogra	2.25
2	Varanasi	2.08
3	Amritsar	2.31

3 Keeping in view the above, the Authority would, henceforth, treat the above said 03 airports as major airports. Ministry is requested to kindly bring the updated position to the notice of all concerned.
