**NOTICE INVITING e-TENDER
(Tender ID: 2018_AAI_)**

E-tenders are invited by Airport Director, AAI, Mangaluru International Airport, Mangaluru on behalf of Chairman, AAI, from eligible contractors for the work "Job Contract for Data Entry Operators for Manning and Accounting Visitors' Entry Ticket Counter" at Mangaluru International Airport at an estimated cost of Rs.2,30,623/- (Excluding GST). Period of completion 6 (six) Months, or till AAT contract is finalized, or closure of the Entry ticket counter due to civil work of Arrival block shifting whichever is earlier. The period is extendable for further 6 months if required by AAI. The broad scope of the work includes handling the Entry ticket selling & accounting.

They should also obtain Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) in parallel which is essentially required for submission of their application. Technical bid(Envelope-I):- shall be uploaded containing in single .pdf format, the below documents:-

- i. Qualifying requirements of Contractor/firm, as per below qualification:-

Qualifying requirements of contractors / firms:- Agency specialized in the similar nature of work and registered with registrar of companies/firms/central Government/State Government as the case may be for Data Entry Operators and permission from the statutory authority to carry out commercial & domestic Data Entry Operators and having PAN & GST.

Should have satisfactorily completed (Phase/Part completion of the scope of work in a contract shall not be considered however pre-determined phasing of the work will be accepted) three works, each of 40% of estimated price i.e. each of Rs.1.85 lakhs or two works, each of 50% of estimated price i.e. each of Rs.2.31 Lakhs or one work of 80% of estimated price i.e. Rs.3.7 Lakhs in single contract of similar nature of work involving Data Entry Operators (Manpower contract for office works/ security jobs/ hiring of vehicles (on pro-rata basis if driver is included in the contract)/ trolley retrieval contract (on pro-rata basis for manpower engaged)/ Operation of E & M installations shall be considered as similar nature of work) during last seven years ending on 31.03.2018 in India.

Client certificate for experience should show the nature of work done, the value of work, date of start, date of completion as per agreement, actual date of completion and satisfactory completion of work. Firms showing work experience certificate from non-government/non-PSU organizations should submit copy of tax deduction at sources certificate in support of their claim for having experience of stipulated value of work.

Should have annualized average financial turnover of Rs.2.77 Lakhs against works executed during last three years ending 31st March of the previous financial year 2018. As a proof, copy of Abridged Balance Sheet along with Profit and Loss Account Statement of the firm should be submitted along with the application. Firms showing continuous losses during the last three years in the balance sheet shall be summarily rejected.

Price bid- Envelope-II(In the CPP portal): - All rates shall be quoted in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. The price bid has been given as a standard **BOQ format** with the tender document, the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the white colored (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.

The Price Bid shall be submitted in e-tendering portal. Unconditional rebate i.e. header discount (%) if any is to be put in "Bid Invitation Information Price Component" section only.

The financial bids of the contractors/firms found to be meeting the technical criteria shall be opened subsequently, after intimating the date in the portal.

Tender fee (Non –Refundable) of **Rs. 530/-** will required to be paid in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Airports Authority of India payable at Mangaluru from Nationalised or any scheduled bank (but not from co- operative or Gramin bank). The Hard copy of original instruments in respect of cost of tender document must be delivered to the Asstt Manager(**Commercial**), **Airports Authority of India, Mangaluru International Airport, Mangaluru – 574142** and should be posted/ given in person to the concerned officials latest as specified in the Tender Document.

EMD of the Value of **Rs.2306/- (Rupees Two Thousand Three Hundred and Six only)** shall be accepted **offline** only in the form of Demand Draft Drawn in favour of Airports Authority of India payable at Mangalore from a nationalized or any scheduled bank (Not from co-operative or Gramin bank). The Hard copy of original instruments in respect of cost of EMD must be delivered to the Asstt Manager(**Commercial**), **Airports Authority of India, Mangaluru International Airport, Mangaluru – 574142** and should be posted/ given in person to the concerned officials latest as specified in the Tender Document.

The bidder who fails to submit the original DD towards Tender Fee & EMD before the stipulated time then their tender shall be rejected out-rightly. Any postal delay will not be entertained.

Refund of EMD:- Refund of EMD of unsuccessful bidders who fail to qualify the eligibility / technical stage shall be initiated **within minimum 7 days** of their rejection. For all bidders who qualify and their financial bids are opened the refund of EMD of all unsuccessful bidders shall be processed within minimum 7 days of opening of the financial bid.

AAI reserve the right to verify the credential submitted by the agency at any stage (before or after the award the work). If at any stage, any information / documents submitted by the applicant is found to be incorrect / false or have some discrepancy which disqualifies the firm then AAI shall take the following action:
 - a) Forfeit the entire amount of EMD submitted by the firm.
 - b) The agency shall be liable for debarment from tendering in AAI, apart from any other appropriate contractual /legal action.
- 3) Consortium /JV companies shall not be permitted. No single firm shall be permitted to submit two separate applications.
- 4) Purchase preference to Central Public Sector undertaking shall be applicable as per the directive of Govt. of India prevalent on the date of acceptance.
- 5) If the entity participating in any of the tenders is a private or public limited company. Partnership firm or proprietary firm and any of the Directors / Partners / Proprietor of such company is also a director of any other company or partner of a concern or a sole proprietor having established business with AAI and has outstanding dues payable to the Authority, then the said entity shall not be allowed to participate in AAI tenders.
- 6) It is mandatory to comply with all applicable laws including minimum wages act. The manpower deployed shall be paid minimum applicable wages for skilled clerical category in Karnataka. No deductions except towards ESI/PF contribution shall be permissible. Any violation may lead to debarring the agency for 3 years in AAI tenders apart from other applicable action as per law.

Envelope –I Technical bid: - Containing documents (uploaded by the contractors/firms) shall be opened as per date mentioned in the tender documents. The intimation regarding acceptance/ rejection of their bids will be intimated to the contractors/firms through CPP portal.

Envelope –II Price bid- The financial bids of the contractors/ firms found to be meeting the qualifying requirements after evaluation shall be opened on subsequent date which **shall be intimated through CPP portal).**
