Terms & Conditions

1. The quotation should be submitted in two parts, Envelope-A (Technical Bid) and Envelope-B (Price Bid), each envelope super scribed “Technical Bid” and “Price Bid” respectively. Both the envelopes should be sealed and put inside the Master envelope and should be sealed properly.

The Master envelope should be super scribed” NIQ for SITC of Batteries of UPS at AAI, Civil Airport, Jammu- 180003 under buy back scheme.

2. Duly completed quotation along with requisite documents should reach this office by registered post, courier or in person at the following address on or before 04-05-2018 up to 1400 HRS Positively.

Quotation will be opened on 04 -05 -2018 at 1500 Hrs. by a Committee constituted by Airport Director, AIRPORTS AUTHORITY OF INDIA, CIVIL AIRPORT, JAMMU and interested bidders may also participate either themselves or their authorized representatives. No separate intimation will be issued for this. Envelope “B” which shall be opened after scrutiny of the basic documents of envelope “A” completion.

3. Technical Bid: (Envelope-A)

The “Technical Bid” should contain only the technical specification details of the offer.
The price must not be written in this bid.

The envelope sealed and super scribed ‘Technical Bid’ should contain:-

- a. **Technical compliance statement** (Annexure – IA) duly filled and signed by the bidder. The submission of compliance statement as described above is essential for evaluation.
- b. **Documentary proof** (Technical brochures or pamphlet) for the offered Make and Model meeting the required specifications as in the compliance statement (The bid without mentioning the offered battery Make and Model in Annexure- IA will be rejected).
- c. **Unconditional acceptance** of AAI terms and conditions on the company’s letter head (Annexure- II) - duly signed by the Bidder.
- d. **Self-attested Copy of valid GSTIN and PAN.**
- e. **OEM/Authorized dealer/ Distributor/Supplier/Contractor registration** or enlistment with CPWD/MES/P&T/Railways/State PWD /PSUs in appropriate class certificate. In case of Authorized dealer /Distributor/Supplier, a certificate from Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) of batteries, which shall be valid and current, shall be submitted.
- f. **Copy of NIQ duly signed on each page.**

4.Price Bid: (Envelope-B)

- a. It may be clearly understood and noted that the 'Price Bid' document is for pricing alone. No condition, whatsoever, should be stipulated in this part. Everything the Bidder has to say, other than pricing, should be stated only in the Technical bid. Any Conditional bid is liable to be rejected.
- b. The Envelope –B sealed and super scribed "Price Bid" should contain the price of the offer in the prescribed format given in Annexure-III.
- c. No additional payment will be made other than quoted amount.
- d. The bidder shall quote the rates in English language and international numerals. The rates shall be in whole numbers. The rates shall be written in both figures as well as in words (in Rupees). In the event of any discrepancy, the price quoted in words will be taken as the correct basis. In case of any ambiguity, all calculations will be carried out taking unit rate as the base.
- e. Price should be inclusive all applicable Taxes.

5.Delivery:

- A. The Successful bidder shall Supply Batteries within 15 days in airport premises at DGM (CNS), O/O- Airport Director, AAI, Civil Airport, Jammu-180003 from the date of receipt of this Purchase Order. Delivery should be carried out without any extra cost.
- b. Date of manufacturing by the company should be within 90 days from the date of supply. The batteries should be delivered in original packing with manufacturing date or month/year embossed in the battery, with serial number or batch code printed or embossed on the battery.
- c. The serial number or batch code of the battery to be printed on the warranty card.
- d. These items to be supplied are of operational necessity and hence the supply period as per contract shall be adhered to strictly. However, in case of extraordinary situations which may delay the supply, the successful bidder shall apply for extension of time in writing.

6.Installation:

- a. Installation and testing of batteries shall be carried out by qualified and experienced person from the battery firm/Authorized Dealer only.
- b. Installation/replacement shall be carried out as per manufacturer recommended practices in addition to the below mentioned methods. The OCV voltage of all the batteries shall be noted immediately after unpacking at Site. The OCV of the individual batteries should not differ more than ± 0.3 V. OCV voltages taken before installation shall be documented.

- c. Load test on battery shall be performed by the successful bidder after the completion of installation/replacement. AAI shall sign the installation report after successful completion of the post Installation testing. Defects / shortcomings brought out in this testing shall have to be attended as per the contract within the permitted time schedule.
- d. After Installation/replacement, Battery capacity test at the actual existing load for at least 10 Min backup, with a specific mention of the load current, voltages of batteries before and after the discharge in the installation report (should adhere to the prescribed voltage discharge level as per the specifications of Battery) shall be performed on site by the manufacturer's/Authorized dealer representative .
- e. The battery load test as said above shall be conducted after full charging of the batteries.
- f. As part of on-site testing, OCV voltages taken before installation shall be documented.
- g. The supplier shall ensure that the batteries to be supplied can be accommodated in existing battery cabinets available, Connected with existing cables and lugs sizes available at the site. If the existing cables and their lugs cannot be used due to the size differences or any other reasons, the supplier shall make arrangements for their supply without additional cost to the buyer.
- h. It is the responsibility of the supplier to bring all the tools required including torque wrench and test equipment (Millimeter, low impedance ohm meter, battery impedance tester, etc.) required for the installation and testing of batteries.
- i. The supplier may inspect the existing batteries, cables and cabinets available with AAI before submitting the quotation and quoting the buyback price.

7. Warranty/Guaranty:

(1) Period of warranty/Guarantee to be of minimum One Year from the date of installation of batteries or Manufacturer warranty whichever is higher for 12V, 42AH batteries. Warranty/Guaranty card should be submitted along with the batteries during the supply.

(2) Period of warranty/Guarantee to be of minimum Two Year from the date of installation of batteries or Manufacturer warranty whichever is higher for 12V, 18AH batteries. Warranty/Guaranty card should be submitted along with the batteries during the supply.

8. Other conditions:

- a. AAI will not be responsible for any delay in submission of quotations sent by post/courier.
- b. The validity of quotation should be for a minimum period of 90 days from the date of opening of the Technical Bid.
- c. In case of a single (or more but not exceeding 10%) battery failure in a bank during the warranty period, defective battery shall be replaced with new battery within 3 working days from the date of receipt of such complaints.

- e. In case, within the warranty period, number of defective batteries (failures) in a bank exceeds 10% of total number of batteries in that bank, then all the batteries in that battery bank shall be replaced with new batteries by supplier at no cost to AAI within 15 days from the date of receipt of such complaint. Incomplete and ambiguous quotations will be rejected.
- f. Quotations once submitted shall be final and no amendment shall be permitted. A Bidder shall submit only one bid.
- g. AAI reserves the right to accept/reject any quotation without assigning any reason.

9. Indemnity:

- a. The successful bidder shall indemnify AAI against claims, damages, loss or penalty caused due to any accident /incident involving the agency.
- b. The successful bidder shall indemnify AAI against any breach or violation of all laws, including labor laws as applicable from time to time.

10. Liquidated Damages: -

In case of failure to execute the order in full within the specified period liquidated damages shall be charged @0.5 % per week or part thereof but not exceeding 5% of the total contract value. Even the order can be cancelled at the risk and cost of the successful bidder.

11. Arbitration and Laws:

All disputes and differences arising out of or in any way touching or concerning this contract (except where otherwise provided for in the contract) shall be referred to the arbitration of the Airport Director, AAI, Civil Airport, Jammu, AAI. The award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. The Rules of Indian Arbitration and Conciliation (Amendment) Act, 2015 shall be applicable. It will be no bar if the Arbitrator appointed as aforesaid is or has been an employee of the Authority and the appointment of the Arbitrator will not be challenged or be open to question in any Court of Law, on this account.

12. Effect and Jurisdiction of Contract:

The contract shall be considered as having come in to force from the date of issue of letter of the award of the contract by AAI. The law applicable to this contract shall be the law enforced in J & State. The courts in Jammu shall have the exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising under this contract.

13. Taxes, Permits & Licenses:

The successful bidders shall be responsible for payment of all Indian duties, levies and taxes lawfully assessed against the successful bidder for his personal income and property only. AAI shall have the right to deduct such taxes, duties at source, if liable to do so under Indian Law.

14. Payment terms:

- a) Payment shall be made after successful SITC and Duly certified by site in-charge.
- b) Payment shall be made through RTGS/NEFT.
- c) Invoice should be in favor of Airports Authority of India and may be submitted to :

Civil Airport, Jammu- 180003.
- d) Bank details (as per Annexure –IV) and Cancelled cheque (of the same account) of bidder should be submitted along with invoice for online payment through RTGS/NEFT.
- e) GST No. of both, bidder and Airports Authority of India should be mentioned in the invoice.
