1. Experience Criteria

Should have satisfactorily completed (Phase/Part completion of the scope of work in a contract shall not be considered, however pre-determined phasing of the work will be accepted) three works, each of Rs. 1820434/- (Eighteen Lakhs Twenty Thousand Four Hundred and Thirty Four) or two works, each of Rs. 22,75,543/- (Twenty Two Lakhs Seventy Thousand Five Hundred and forty Three) or one work of Rs. 3640869 (Thirty Six Lakhs Forty Thousand eight Hundred and Sixty Nine) in single contract of similar nature work during last seven years from the last date of submission of bid.

Client certificate for experience should show the nature of work done, the value of work, date of start, date of completion as per agreement, actual date of completion and satisfactory completion of work. Firms showing work experience certificate from Non-government / Non-PSU organisation should submit “Tax Deduction at Source Certificate” in support of their claim for having experience of stipulated value of works.

Similar nature of work is defined as “Engaging/Providing/Deputing/Supplying manpower or Manpower outsourcing during last seven years ending on last date of submission of bid”.

2. Bidder Turnover

Client should have an Average Annual Financial Turnover of minimum Rs. 1365326 /- (Thirteen Lakhs Sixty Five Thousand Three Hundred and Twenty Six) against works executed during last three years ending 31st March in each financial year (2021-2022, 2022-23, 2023-24). As a proof, copy of CA certified (with UDIN) Turnover of the firm should be submitted along with the Application.

3. Certificate / Documents (Requested in Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC))

- (i) Work Experience Certificate as per the experience criteria.in Clause 1 above.
- (ii) GST registration certificate
- (iii) In case of experience of Private Sector, Bidder has to submit TDS certificate issued by the customer in support of payment received and execution of work.
- (iv) Average Annual Turnover certificate for last 3 years (F.Y., 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24) certified by CA with UDIN as mentioned in clause 2 above.
- (v) Scanned Copy of PAN Card.
- (vi) Unconditional Acceptance of AAI Bid Conditions on Company Letter head. (**Annexure- I**)
- (vii) Undertaking regarding debarment/blacklisting on Company letter head. (**Annexure-II**).
- (viii) **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 91,022/-** will be required to be paid online in form of RTGS in favor of Airports Authority of India payable at Goa. The details of AAI, Goa mandate for making payment under electronic mode through RTGS are provided in **Annexure III**. Non-submission, of EMD shall lead to disqualification of bidders.

- (ix) Affidavit Regarding Minimum wages as per **Annexure- IV**.
- (x) **The agency is required to arrange Airport Entry Permit (AEP) from BCAS for its staff/employees individually. Agency must give undertaking in this regard as per Annexure V.**

4. Scope of Work & Job Description

- a) At least one medical personnel shall be available at designated location in airport premises at all times.
- b) Goa International Airport, Dabolim is operational 24X7 year-round; hence one day shall mean three shifts of eight hours each. In each shift one medical personnel shall be available without fail.
- c) Conduction of Breath Analyser test of officials as per regulatory requirement. (Breath Analyser Equipment will be provided by AAI).
- d) To run software of randomisation for selection of employees for BA Test. (Necessary Hardware and Software for this purpose will be provided by AAI).
- e) Maintenance of related Records / Documents as instructed by HOD Airport Director or his/her authorised representative as and when required.
- f) Creation of database related to Breath Analyser reports.
- g) Other related works assigned to them by Airport Director or his/her authorised representative as and when required.
- h) First Aid Services at Goa International Airport, Dabolim as and when required by Airport Director or his/her authorised representative.
- i) Monthly duty roster of the deployed manpower shall be prepared and maintained by the agency and a copy to be submitted with Airport Director or his/her authorised representative before starting of every month and at no point of time the position of Medical Personnel shall remain vacant.
- j) Any reliever required to meet the requirement of 24X7 deployments, shall be arranged by the agency/ bidder without any extra cost.
- k) The medical personnel shall perform the work of breath analyser examination test to the satisfaction of Airport Director or his/ her authorised representative.

- l) The work force deployed/ engaged for this Contract shall be the regular employee of the Contractor.
- m) The Contractor shall be responsible for the compliance of all the provisions of all the labour laws applicable for such work force and their service condition in his own establishment and for settlement of any dispute arising out of the terms and conditions of services of the personnel.

5. SECURITY / WORKING IN RESTRICTED AREA

The work is required to be executed at Goa Airport, which is a sensitive and high security zone. The successful agency has to follow the security requirements in his day-to-day work. The successful agency shall be sensitive and responsive to the safety and security factors which are of primary importance in today's Airport Environment. Bidders are expected to include security as a consideration in all aspects of their planning.

The agency is required to arrange Airport Entry Permit (AEP) from BCAS for its staff/employees individually. Agency must give undertaking in this regard as per Annexure V.

The credentials and conduct guarantee are to be obtained from concerned Police Station, verified by the agency and to be submitted with AAI for all the staff/employees individually before deployment. Staff/employee should not be changed frequently once the verification of character and antecedents are done. Any other formalities as applicable/enforced from time to time shall be complied with at no extra cost. No claim what so ever on this shall be allowed. Incidental expenses incurred towards such police verifications shall be borne by the agency. **Expenditure for obtaining Security clearance, approved security programme and Airport Entry Permit from the concerned department for Staff / personnel employed to enter into the Terminal Buildings shall be borne by agency.**

6. Conduct of medical personnel:

If at any time the work or Conduct of any medical personnel is found unsatisfactory or in-disciplined or without uniform/PIC or otherwise in any manner deficient to the requirements of the terms & conditions of the contract by AAI, such persons shall be removed by the Agency immediately with suitable substitute.

7. Statutory Requirements:

It shall be the sole liability of the Contractor (including the Contracting firm/Company) to obtain and to abide by all necessary licenses/permission from the authorities concerned as provided under the various labour legislation including the labour license obtained as per the provisions of the Contract Labour (R&A) Act 1970. The Contractor shall discharge obligations as provided under various applicable statutory enactments including EPF and Miscellaneous provision Act 1952, Employees State Insurance (ESI) Act 1948, Contract Labour (R&A) Act 1970, Inter State migrate workmen (Regulation of employment and condition of service) Act 1979, the Minimum Wages Act 1948, the payment of wages Act 1936, the workmen's compensation Act 1923, per Application Notification Under the Minimum Wages Act of the Central Government and other relevant act, rules and regulations, instructions etc. issued/enforced from time to time.

On commencement of the Contract, the Contractor shall continue to have valid PF code number till conclusion of the Contract. AAI reserves the right to withhold any payment in running bill, if PF contribution, GST and Bonus are not paid by the Contractor and satisfactory proof to that effect have not been produced along with the monthly Tax invoice by the Contractor.

8. Hike in Minimum Wages:

Payment of difference in wages due to increase in minimum wages by Govt. plus difference of mandatory contribution by the Contractor towards PF, ESIC, Bonus due to increase in minimum wages shall be reimbursed to the Contractor only on production of satisfactory proof as desired by the Airport Director or his authorised representative.

9. Payment to Medical Personnel:

The Contractor shall be solely responsible for the payment of wages and other dues to the workers deployed by him latest by 7th of the subsequent month. Necessary action as deemed fit may be initiated by AAI if payments are not made to the workers latest by 7th of subsequent month. The monthly wages payment due to the workers should be remitted directly in the workers' bank account and not to be paid in Cash or any other mode. The Contractor shall be directly responsible and indemnify the Authority against all charges, dues, claims etc. arising out of the disputes relating to the dues and employment of personnel deployed by him.

10. Debarment/ Blacklisting:

AAI reserve the right to verify the credentials submitted by the agency at any stage (before or after the award the work). If at any stage, any information / documents submitted by the applicant is found to be incorrect / false or have some discrepancy which disqualifies the firm, the firm shall be liable for debarment/blacklisting for a period of 3 (three) years from tendering in AAI, apart from any other appropriate Contractual / legal action.

11. Conduct of Medical Personnel:

The persons so employed shall not report for duty if not medically fit and/or under influence of alcohol or any other sedative material and accordingly the Contractor should arrange for substitute manpower / replacement immediately as per the requirement. The persons so employed shall not smoke, consume alcohol or any other sedative material in the operational area and while on duty.

If the continuance/performance of any of the persons deployed by the Contractor is found not satisfactory by the Airport Director or his authorised representative, the contractor shall replace him forthwith, upon receipt of information to that effect, from AAI.

12. Familiarization of job functions:

The Contractor shall brief medical personnel thoroughly about safety/security rules at the airport. Contractor shall also train/familiarize medical personnel on the procedure of Breath analyser Test.

13. Determination of the Contract:

The dispute resolution shall be dealt with in accordance with GeM and AAI Policy.

14. Compensation of Damages:

The Contractor shall be responsible for settling any claim / compensation against all damages and accidents caused due to negligence on the part of his/her employees and keep AAI indemnified from any compensation/liability. AAI shall not be responsible for any injury sustained by Contractor's workers during the performance of their duties and also any damages or compensation due to any dispute between him/her and his/her workers. The Contractor shall comply with all provisions of Labour Acts/Enactments hitherto in force or enacted from time to time during execution of this Contract and Contractor shall be responsible for all liabilities arising out of these provisions. Furthermore, the Contractor shall be responsible for payment of compensation, insurance etc. if any, in respect of his/her employees.

15. Mediclaim Policy:

Wherever ESI is not applicable, Contractor /agency shall take a group Mediclaim policy covering health care of minimum Rs.2 lacs/ annum for each employee. No extra payment in this regard shall be made by AAI. Documentary proof of commencement of the mediclaim policy and subsequent renewal of the same is to be submitted to Airport Director or his authorised representative after award of work.

16. Medical Personnel Details:

The Contractor shall furnish all the details of the persons to be employed like Names, address, photo, age, specimen signature, Govt. ID proof, etc. and authority shall have the liberty to reject any person.

17. Bill submission/ Monthly payment:

Monthly payment shall be made in the following month after deducting any or all recoveries, penalties, etc. which the contractor might have rendered himself liable. The Contractor has to submit his bill every month for the completed period of one month with all supporting documents as required latest by 10th of the following month. Monthly bill submitted by the agency shall include proof of salary paid to the medical personnel and PF & ESIC statement as applicable.

18. Security Deposit:

The tenderer/bidder/firms, whose tender is accepted, will be required to furnish Performance Security/ Performance Bank Guarantee of 5% (Five Percent) of the Contract Amount within 30 days of issuance of work order. This guarantee shall be in the form of Bank Guarantee of Nationalized Bank or any Scheduled Bank but not Co-Operative or Gramin Bank, in accordance with the prescribed form, provided confirmatory advice is enclosed.

The Bank Guarantee will remain valid till claim period as per contract provisions will be required to be paid online in form of Bank Guarantee (BG) (along with copy of the SFMS-Structured Financial Messaging System) BG confirmation message sent by the BG issuing

bank to ICICI bank from a Nationalized or scheduled bank but not from Co-Operative or Gramin/ Rural bank.

The Performance Security/ Performance Bank Guarantee shall be initially valid up to the stipulated date of completion plus 90 days beyond that. In case the time for completion of work gets extended, the contractor shall get the validity of Bank Guarantee extended to cover such extended time for completion of work. After recording of the completion certificate or the work by the competent authority, the bank guarantee shall be returned to the contractor, without any interest.

In case the Contractor fails to submit the Performance Security/ Performance Bank Guarantee within stipulated period, interest at 12% p.a. on Performance Guarantee amount would be levied (non-refundable) for delayed period of submission and shall be deducted from the first bill payable to the Contractor. In case, successful bidder fails to submit Performance Security/ Performance Bank Guarantee within 60 days of the issue of the letter of acceptance of his bid, AAI reserve the right to forfeit EMD and cancel the order.

19. Commencement of Work:

The work shall commence from the date on which Airport Director, Goa International Airport or his/her representative issues work order. If the Contractor commits default in commencing the work as aforesaid, AAI shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at liberty to forfeit the earnest money (EMD) absolutely.

20. Agreement:

Successful bidder shall complete within 15 days all Contractual formalities after the date of Commencement of Work as detailed below: -

- a) Security Deposit
- b) Signing the contract agreement on non-judicial stamp paper of 100 Rs.
- c) Training/Familiarisation of staff

21. Bid Submission:

AAI is not responsible for any delay due to link failure /internet problem etc. in respect of submission or receipt of any documents or in submission of e-Bid. Bidders who are intending to submit responsive bids are requested to submit the same well in advance before the due date & time. It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to make sure that the required documents / Bids are submitted in GeM Portal on time.

22. Rejection Of Bid:

- i.** Airports Authority of India reserves the right to reject any or part of Bid without assigning any reason. The documentation submitted by Bidders shall not be returned. AAI also reserves the right at its sole discretion not to award any order under this Bid call. These decisions do not commit AAI to pay any costs or loss incurred directly or indirectly what so ever.
- ii.** If the Bidder deliberately gives wrong information in his Bid, AAI reserves the right to reject such Bid at any stage or to cancel the Contract, if awarded.
- iii.** Bid in which any of the particulars and prescribed information are missing or are incomplete, in any respect and/or prescribed conditions are not fulfilled, shall be considered non-responsive and is liable to be rejected.
- iv.** No correspondence shall be entertained from the Bidders after the opening of Price bid of the Bid unless called by AAI.
- v.** Bids with incomplete/ambiguous details are liable to be rejected without seeking any further clarification.
- vi.** AAI reserves the right to verify the credential submitted by the agency at any stage (before or after the award the work). If any stage, any information/documents submitted by the applicant is found to be incorrect/false or have some discrepancy which disqualifies the firm then AAI shall take the following action:

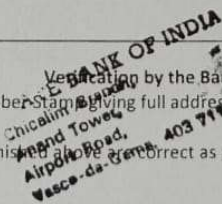
