NOTICE INVITING E- TENDER (2 BOT- 2 Envelope Open Tender)

1. Item rate e-tendering are invited through the e-tendering CPP Portal by Asstt. Gen. Manager (Engg-C)-I, AAI, Jaipur International Airport, Jaipur-302029 (Bid Manager) on behalf of Chairman, A.A.I. from the eligible contractors for the work of **“Grade correction of existing runway 09 – 27 at Jaipur International Airport, Jaipur”. SH : Providing of vehicles for Civil Engineering office at Jaipur International Airport, Jaipur (IInd Re- Call)”** at an estimated cost of Rs. **7,51,440.00 (Excluding GST)** with period of completion **06 (Six) Months**.

The tendering process is online at CPP-portal URL address <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app> or www.aai.aero. Prospective Tenderers may download and go through the tender document.

Prospective tenderers are advised to get themselves register at CPP-portal, obtain 'Login ID' & Password and go through the instructions available in the home page after login to the CPP-portal <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app> or www.aai.aero. They should also obtain Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) in parallel which is essentially required for submission of their application. The process normally takes 03 days time. The tenderer may also take guidance from AAI help desk support through path aai.aero/tender/e-tender/help desk support.

Tender processing fee of **Rs. 1180/- (i/c GST) Non refundable** will be required to be paid offline in the form of Demand Draft in favor of **"AAI REVENUE COLLECTION A/C NO. 64960200000010"** payable at Jaipur. (respective Airport) from Nationalised or any scheduled bank (but not from co-operative or Gramin bank). The original Demand Draft against Tender processing fee should reach by post/courier/given in person to the concerned official by the date as specified in the Critical Data Sheet of Tender Document. The details of Demand Draft/any other accepted instruments, physically sent, should tally with the details available in the scanned copy and the data entered during bid submission time.

Envelope-I (Tender processing fee, EMD, Technical Bid and Pre-qualification): -
Bid containing following:

A. Tender processing fee, EMD:

- i. Scanned copy of DD against Tender Processing Fee.
- ii. Scanned copy of DD or BG against EMD (as per Appendix-1A) along with letter of undertaking (as per Appendix –XIA).

B. Technical Bid containing the following:-

- i. Scanned copy of Unconditional Acceptance of AAI's Tender Conditions.
- ii. Scanned copy of Permanent Account Number (PAN) and GST Registration Number.
- iii. Scanned copy of 'Undertaking' regarding Minimum wages and Blacklisting /Debarment on Company's Letter Head.
- iv. Tenderer should deploy sufficient plant and machinery as per the requirement of work in consultation with the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC) to achieve the

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milestones/targets and overall completion within the time period. Tenderer shall submit scanned copy of 'Undertaking' on Company's Letter Head.

- v. Companies other than propriety firm shall submit, scanned copy of Authorization Letter/Power of Attorney along with copy of Certificate of Incorporation of the Company under Companies Act showing CIN/LLPIN/Name of Directors of the Company & Copy of Board Resolution regarding Authority to assign Power of Attorney.

Proprietary firm shall submit scanned copy of Authorization Letter/Power of Attorney only if the Tender is processed by a person other than Proprietor.

- vi. PQ Performa duly filled.

c. Qualifying requirements of contractors/tenderers containing the following: -

- i) Should have satisfactorily completed (# Phase/Part completion of the scope of work in a contract shall not be considered, **however pre-determined phasing of the work will be accepted**) three works, each of **Rs. 3.01 Lakhs** or two works, each of **Rs. 3.76 Lakhs** or one work of **Rs. 6.01 Lakhs** in single contract of similar nature of job during last seven years ending on **October 2020**.

"The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of submission of bid 28.10.2020.

Client certificate for experience should show the nature of work done, the value of work, date of start, date of completion as per agreement, actual date of completion and satisfactory completion of work. Tenderers **showing work experience certificate from non-government/non-PSU organizations should submit copy of tax deduction at sources (TDS) certificate (s) alongwith a certificate issued by registered chartered Accountant, clearly specifying the name of work, total payment received against the work and TDS amount for the work.**

- ii) Should have annualized average financial turnover of **Rs. 2.26 Lakhs** against works executed during last three years ending 31st March of the previous financial year. As a proof, copy of Abridged Balance Sheet along with Profit and Loss Account Statement of the firm should be submitted along with the application. Firms showing continuous losses for the last three years in the balance sheet shall be summarily rejected.
- iii) The tenderer should have a minimum net worth of **Rs. 1.13 Lakhs** issued by certified Chartered Accountants.
- (iv) The agency should have valid registration as transporter.

(v) **The agency should provide two Numbers Air Conditioned passenger vehicles for 06 months**, Minimum Seven Seater (make/ model Xylo/Innova/ Tavera/Scorpio/ Marazzo) on regular basis for 12 hrs work including lunch time with 2500 KM per month at Jaipur Airport civil engineering office at Jaipur airport.

(vi) The Firm should submit list of Vehicle owned by agency, with the details of Registration Number, Make, Model, Year of Manufacture, Road Tax Paid upto, Insurance valid upto, Fitness Valid upto, Name of Owner or duly Notarized Power of Attorney (POA) (If, vehicle is not in the name of tenderer).

(vii) The vehicle, should be originally registered with RTO not prior to the year 2016. The Vehicle should be registered in the Commercial use Category. Copy of RC Book with update Fitness Certificate, RTO Tax, Insurance and Pollution under Control Certificate (if applicable) should be deposited along with the Pre-Qualification cum Technical Bid.

viii) Agency should have valid PF & ESI registration.

(In case EPF & ESI registration are not available with bidder while submitting tender. Bidder shall submit undertaking to submit EPF & ESI registration after award of work)

Scanned copy of all the Documents of Envelop-I mentioned above shall be submitted on the CPP portal. Original/Hard Copies of DD against Tender Processing fee and DD/BG against EMD is required to be submitted/sent to the Asstt. Gen. Mgr. (Engg – C)-I, Room no. G2, Ground floor, Engineering office, Residential Colony, AAI, Jaipur Airport, Jaipur-302029 on or before date & time mentioned in CRITICAL DATA SHEET. The tenderer, whose DD against Tender Processing fee and DD/BG against EMD are not received by the date & time mentioned in critical date sheet, then their tenders will be liable to be rejected. Any postal delay will not be entertained.

EMD of value of Rs.15,029/- shall be accepted offline only in the form of Demand Draft/Bank Guarantee from a Nationalized or any scheduled bank (but not from Co-Operative or Gramin bank).

Refund of EMD

The refund of EMD to tenderers, who fail to qualify in the eligibility/technical criteria, shall be initiated within 7 days of their rejection. For all tenderers who qualify after their financial bids are opened, the refund of EMD all such tenderers except L-1 shall be processed within 7 days of opening of the financial bid.

Envelope-II:- The Financial e-Bid through CPP portal.

All rates shall be quoted in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the Tenderers. Tenderers are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the blue coloured (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as

name of the Tenderers). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the Tenderers should save it and submit it online, without changing the file name. If the BOQ file is found modified by the Tenderers, the bid will be rejected.

3. Bid Submission:-

The tenderer shall submit their application only at CPP portal: <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>. Tenderer/Contractor are advised to follow the instruction provided in the tender document for online submission of bids. Tenderers are required to upload the digitally signed file of scanned documents as per Para 2. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

Uploading of application in location other than specified above shall not be considered. Hard copy of application shall not be entertained.

4. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one tenderer or tenderers having business relations. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relation who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.

5. Tenderer who has downloaded the tender from Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) [websitehttp://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app](http://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app), shall not tamper/modify the tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered/modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and tenderer is liable to be banned from doing business with AAI.

6. Bids Opening Process is as below:-

Envelope-I: (Tender processing fee, EMD, Technical bid and Pre-qualification):

Envelop-I containing documents as per Para 2 (A), (B) and (C) (uploaded by the tenderers) shall be opened on date & time mentioned in CRITICAL DATASHEET.

If the Tenderers has any query related to the Bid Document of the work, they should use Seek Clarification on CPP portal to seek clarifications. No other means of communication in this regard shall be entertained.

If any clarification is needed from the tenderer about the deficiency in his uploaded documents in Envelope – I, he will be asked to provide it through CPP portal or email is required. The tenderer shall upload the requisite clarification/documents within time specified by AAI, failing which it shall be presumed that the Tenderers does not have anything to submit and bid shall be evaluated accordingly.

The intimation regarding acceptance/rejection of their bids will be intimated to the tenderers through CPP portal.

Envelope-II: - (Financial Bid):

Envelope-II: Envelop-II containing financial bid of the tenderers found to be meeting the technical criteria and qualifying requirements shall be opened on date & time mentioned in per CRITICAL DATA SHEET. (In case the date and time for opening of Envelop-II (Financial Bid) is required to be changed, the same shall be intimated through CPP portal.

4. AAI reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications without assigning any reasons. AAI also reserves the right to call off tender at any stage without assigning any reason.
5. AAI reserve the right to disallow issue of tender document to working agencies whose performance at ongoing project (s) is below par and usually poor and has been issued letter of restrain/Temporary/Permanent debarment/black listing by any department of AAI or Central/State Govt. Depts./PSIs/World Bank/ADB etc. **AAI reserve the right to verify the credential submitted by the agency at any stage (before or after the award of work). If at any stage, any information /documents submitted by the applicant is found to be incorrect/false or have some discrepancy which disqualifies the Tenderers then AAI shall take the following action:**
 - a) **Forfeit the entire amount of EMD submitted by the Tenderer.**
 - b) **The tenderer shall be liable for debarment from tendering in AAI, including termination of the contract apart from any other appropriate contractual/legal action.**
6. Consortium/JV companies shall not be permitted. No single firm shall be permitted to submit two separate applications.
7. Purchase preference to Central Public Sector Undertaking shall be applicable as per the directive of Govt. of India prevalent on the date of acceptance.
8. Concessions to Indian Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) units registered with DIC/NSIC/KVIC/KVIB/Directorate of Handicraft and handloom etc. To be given as per the provisions of public procurement policy for MSEs order 2012 with up to date amendments, shall be applicable for tenders of supply/services and shall not be extended to construction work.
